Subject: Proposed E6 Freeway width

Hi Robyn

Thank you for your email today regarding the width of the proposed E6 freeway.

Our current understanding is that there will be no further land acquired in Epping for the development of the freeway.

This is because the proposed 6 lane freeway through the established areas (Epping, Mill Park and Thomastown) will be built within the existing 95 metre road reservation. However, the proposed freeway north of these existing areas (the alignment of which has not yet been confirmed by VicRoads) will be 120 metres wide.

VicRoads have confirmed that the freeway can fit within the designated 95 metre road reserve, with some design changes to the cross section.
